On 07/11/2017 at approximately 1800 hours, I responded to 1868A W. Hillsboro Blvd Deerfield Beach, FL 33442 in reference to a Robbery. Upon arrival, I made contact with Nagui Yassa 09/13/49 who stated at approximately 1725 hours, Yassa was exiting the Preferred Property International where he works and 1 unknown black male approx. 18-20 YOA, skinny build, wearing dark jeans, gray shirt, and 1 unknown black female approx. 18-20 YOA, wearing white shirt and light colored jeans approached him from the bench that is just south of the business and asked for a dollar.

Yassa stated he did not understand what the black male was saying at first so Yassa continued to approach his 2010 White Mercedes FL tag# Y9GWP.

Yassa stated the black male then approached him and started punching him and pushed Yassa to the ground and at which time Yassa's keys and cell phone went flying from his hand.

Item:

- 1) Silver Iphone 6+ (unknown serial number) cellphone# 954-871-4990
- 2) Car Keys

Yassa stated at which time the black female and black male jumped on top of him and started punching him and then grabbed his keys and cellphone and jumped in Yassa's vehicle.

Yassa stated the subjects fled northbound on S. Military Trl and then headed eastbound through the plaza just south of W. Hillsboro Blvd located on east side of S. Military Trl.

While on scene dispatch attempted to track Yassa's cellphone but was unsuccessful due to the cellphone being turned off.

An area canvas was conducted and there is no video surveillance in the area where the incident occurred.

During the investigation I responded to Chevron Gas Station where Yassa stated the subjects fled towards which is located at 1790 W. Hillsboro Blvd Deerfield Beach, FL 33442.

I observed video surveillance on the south of the building that possibly could have captured the vehicle fleeing through the plaza. I made contact with Cashier Jean Registre 10/30/78 who stated the Manager Rina would have to access the video surveillance. Registre stated Rina works Monday- Friday from approximately 10:00am-3:00pm. Phone number to the business is 954-360-0616.

Yassa signed the Auto Theft Affidavit stating he will press charge and the vehicle was entered into the system as stolen by Teletype Operator Davis 18168. The Auto Theft Affidavit was placed into Records.

Yassa obtain a scratch on his left lower leg during the altercation but refused Fire Rescue. Pictures were taken of Yassa on scene by Deputy Black and uploaded to Evidence.com.

A BOLO for the vehicle was issued for jurisdictional counties.

Offense ROBBERY

On Wednesday, July 26, 2017 at approximately 07:01 hours, I was dispatched to 278 S Federal HWY (Tijuana Flats) Deerfield Beach FL reference to armed robbery just occurred.

Upon arrival I met with Juan Aaron Garcia JR (w/m 07-29-1992) who advised that he has just been robbed. Garcia advised he came to work, and opened the front door like he does every morning. Right after he unlocked the front door, unknown male approached him from the back, and put a gun to his back and stated "come give me all the money". Garcia complied, walked in the business and opened the safe for the unknown male. The unknown male then ordered Garcia to put the money in a plastic bag. Garcia gave the unknown male some of the money from the safe, and then was ordered to lay on the ground.

The unknown male took an unknown amount cash from the safe, and ran towards the back door and exited the business. Right after the unknown male left business, [REDACTED] quickly got up from the floor ran to the front door to lock it, and called 911.

Several deputies responded to the area, and established a perimeter. During our search for the subject, John J Gass (w/m 8-28-58), advised to one of the deputies that he saw a black male running south on S Federal HWY, to Saint Ambrose Church (380 S Federal HWY), got in a black vehicle and left the area, last seen heading north bound on S Federal HWY. A Bolo was issued with the new information.

Deputy Larkin responded to Orchard Supply Hardware Store (340 s Federal HWY Deerfield Beach) and reviewed their surveillance video. Surveillance showed the subject running through the parking lot after the robbery to his getaway vehicle. Deputy Larkin down loaded the footage on his issued tablet for evidence.

Garcia described the unknown male as black male about 6'2 to 6'4, medium built, wearing black sweater with a hoodie, long pants (unknown color possibly black), unknown shoes, with a hand gun.

Assistance General Manager, Zachary L Gundersen (w/m 10-12-87), responded on scene, and later advised me that the unknown male left the business with \$ [REDACTED].

Crime Scene Investigative Aid Barbara Ellis 10853, responded to the business and processed the business for evidence, see her report for further.

Detective Neil Munson CCN 11490 from Criminal Investigation also responded on scene.

I provided Zachary a case number regarding the incident.
